

First of all congratulation on your wedding!!! Every wedding is different but to give you an idea what it would cost to have a professional photographer document your wedding, here are few packages that might help you.

Please note that packages can be customized to your needs.

### Half-day

- 6h of documenting
- 150-200 Highres images on a CD/DVD
- Private online gallery for 30 days
- **800\$**

### Full-day

- 12h of documenting
- 350-400 Highres images on a CD/DVD
- Private online gallery for 30 days
- **1200\$**

### Album

- 12x12 inch leather book in a slipcase
- 15 spreads (30 pages)
- 40 edited images.
- Add **1300\$** to any above packages

### Prints

- Invitation/Thank you -cards 210x98 mm (min 8) **15\$**
- Table size 6x8 (Crop) inch **40\$**
- 8x12 (Crop) inch **50\$**
- 12x18 (Fullframe) inch **80\$**
- 16x24 (Fullframe) **120\$**
- 24x36 (Fullframe) **210\$**

### Photo editing

Hourly rate for this kind of work is **40\$/hour**. How many hours are required, depends on the style you are after. I'll give you a fixed price before starting so there won't be any surprises.

### All prices include

GST and travelling in Melbourne CBD+30km

### Booking

Booking fee is **500\$** which is subtracted from your total investment.



**FAQ****How many photos do I get?**

- Roughly between 30-40 images/hour.

**How is the album put together?**

- After the wedding, you just need to go online and choose between 30-50 images that you wish to add to this book. Next step is that I'll design the layout and send it to you for approval. If there's something about the layout you don't like, no worries there's a one round of corrections that is included. Then you just relax and wait for me to give you a ring when it's ready. Usually takes about 3weeks.

**What is photoediting?**

- Also known as Photoshopping, basically this means altering the original photo to achieve desired effect. This can, for example be blemish removal, color alteration or even removing unwanted people from the photo...oh yes, it has happened.

**What does Crop and Fullframe mean?**

- In a nutshell it means that the ratio of an image from a digital camera is 1:1.5, meaning that the image is 1.5 times as long as it's wide (Fullframe). When the ratio of a print is different, there are parts of the original image that are cut off (cropped). Luckily ratios are quite close so it's not the end of the world.

**What about pre wedding photography?**

- Can absolutely be arranged, it's a good way of testing your makeup and wedding dress or to get some casual photos of the two of you. These images also work well in the invitations. Additional photoshoot with the two of you, would cost 500\$.

**How much is the Travelling fee?**

- If you're planning to have your wedding outside Melbourne CBD+30km additional travelling fees may apply (1\$/km one way only).

**Can I have less than 6hrs?**

- How can I say no? In these cases hourly rate is 150\$/h and minimum booking is 3hrs.
